Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Amendment Bill 2010

It has come to the Society's attention that the *Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Amendment Bill 2010* is listed to be debated during the parliamentary session commencing Monday 7 February. We understand that it is on the Notice Paper for Tuesday.

The Society has previously prepared a submission in respect of this Bill (copy attached). You will note that the Society has a number of concerns.

We understand that some amendments to the Bill may be moved to address some of those concerns particularly on the topic of recovery from hit and run drivers.

However, it is the Society's position that the proposed amendments relating to

- Sanctions against non-cooperative insureds' and nominal defendant's powers to compel uninsured drivers to cooperate
- Provision of evidence
- Liability – Section 127 AB1(b)
- Damages – Section 127 AB(2)
- Section 127 AB(3)
- Section 127 AB(4)
- Fraud – Section 127 AB(5)
- Assessment for non-economic loss damages
- Transitional provisions
